









Passenger Traffic (2020/2021 vs. 2019)







(Passenger Traffic: 2021 vs. 2019)














Omicron wave subsiding...






New research shows travel restrictions in the EU had little or no impact on the spread of Omicron



Airline seats from European airports (millions)






Bookings for the Easter & Summer holidays increase


