The organisation's Annual Assembly & Congress, and the Commercial & Retail Conference – originally scheduled during the spring / summer – have new dates, a fresh line-up, and will set the stage for the industry's return to business strength.

Our Annual Assembly & Congress will now be held on 20-22 October 2020, in Geneva, Switzerland. We're delighted to remain with our host Genève Aéroport in their centennial year. The new later date in October will allow the airport community, including C-suite airport leaders, our business partners and Institutional stakeholders to gather as one and unite, to take stock and address the new reality as we shape our industry moving forwards.
