## ACI Airport Exchange kicks off in Oslo, hosted by Avinor

**Oslo, 26 November 2018**: This week, the **12th ACI Airport Exchange** conference & exhibition takes place at the prestigious new Norway Convention Center in Oslo. The event, which combines an extensive airport services & equipment exhibition with 4 specialist conferences addressing key aspects of airport management & operations, is staged jointly by two regions of Airports Council International, ACI EUROPE and ACI Asia-Pacific, with the support of ACI World.

With more than 50 exhibitors, 120 speakers and over 900 participants expected, the event is one of the biggest in the air transport sector's annual calendar. This year's theme is "*Developing sustainable airports, secure airports, safe airports...successful airports*".
