



# Augustin de Romanet elected to lead airport industry trade association

**Prague, 26 June 2015:** European airports' trade association Airports Council International Europe (ACI EUROPE) this morning held its Annual Assembly, as part of the 25<sup>th</sup> ACI EUROPE Annual Assembly, Congress & Exhibition, hosted by Prague Airport.

During the Assembly meeting, **Mr Augustin de Romanet, President & CEO of Aéroports de Paris** was elected to lead the organisation as President.

Addressing the membership **Mr de Romanet** said *"I am honoured to assume the role of President of ACI EUROPE. Recent years have shown that the air transport sector must face multiple challenges and we need strong representation among policymakers and regulators at EU level"*.
