

## The ACI EUROPE Commercial Forum

### Background

- The Executive Committee of the ACI EUROPE Board decided on 11 June 2003 in London to create a permanent Forum for members interested in the generation of non-aeronautical revenue at airports.

### Mission

- The mission of the forum is to promote and develop best practice in the generation of non-aeronautical revenue at airports, including among others retail, forex, parking, car rental, real estate and airport cities.

### Membership

- The ACI EUROPE Commercial Forum is open to all Regular Members and World Business Partners and currently counts over 120 active Members. The Forum holds two annual meetings, one within the framework of the ACI EUROPE Commercial and Retail Conference, and one in the autumn.

### Task Forces

- There are currently three working groups: 1) real estate and airport cities; 2) data exchange; 3) development of the concession model; and 4) drafting of the next conference programme.

### Officers

- The current Chair is Elias Liolios (Hermes Airports); the Vice-Chair is Mats Klevjer (Airmagine) the next elections will take place in the autumn of 2020.

### Next meetings

- The autumn meeting will take place in Budapest, 12 October 2019. The spring meeting will take place in Prague on 21 March 2020.
